Applies to all user generated content across Quantisca platforms

1. Introduction

These User Content & Community Guidelines (“Guidelines”) govern all content submitted, posted, uploaded, shared, or otherwise made available by users (“User Content”) on any Quantisca (“we”, “us”, “our”) platform, including forums, comments, reviews, discussions, and community spaces (“Community”).

By participating in the Community, you agree to these Guidelines.

2. User Responsibility

Users are fully responsible for:

- the content they publish
- ensuring accuracy and legality
- respecting others
- complying with all Quantisca policies
- avoiding harmful or misleading behavior

Quantisca is not responsible for User Content.

3. Prohibited Content

Users may not post, share, or upload:

3.1. Illegal Content

- unlawful material
- copyrighted content without permission
- stolen or pirated software
- personal data of others

3.2. Harmful or Abusive Content

- harassment
- threats
- hate speech
- discrimination
- defamation
- bullying

3.3. Misleading or Dangerous Content

- false claims
- financial promises
- guaranteed profit statements
- impersonation of Quantisca or others

3.4. Spam & Unwanted Promotion

- unsolicited advertising
- affiliate links
- referral codes
- promotional posts
- repetitive or irrelevant content

3.5. Security Violations

- malware

- harmful scripts
- attempts to exploit vulnerabilities
- sharing confidential Quantisca information

3.6. Inappropriate Content

- explicit material
- violent content
- offensive imagery
- political or extremist content

Quantisca may remove prohibited content without notice.

4. Content Ownership & License

By posting User Content, you grant Quantisca a:

- worldwide
- royalty free
- transferable
- perpetual
- irrevocable

license to use, reproduce, modify, distribute, and display the content for operational and community purposes.

You retain ownership of your content, but Quantisca may use it as needed.

5. Moderation Rights

Quantisca may, at its sole discretion:

- remove or edit User Content
- restrict posting privileges
- suspend or terminate accounts
- block access to the Community
- delete discussions or threads
- enforce rules without explanation

Moderation decisions are final.

6. Reporting Violations

Users may report inappropriate content.

Quantisca may review reports but is not obligated to:

- act on every report
- provide updates
- justify moderation decisions

7. No Liability for User Content

Quantisca is not liable for:

- content posted by users
- actions of community members
- reliance on user opinions
- misinformation shared by users

Users participate at their own risk.

8. No Financial Advice

User Content must not:

- provide investment advice
- promise profits
- recommend trades
- misrepresent risks

All trading decisions are the user's responsibility.

9. Community Conduct

Users must:

- communicate respectfully
- avoid personal attacks

- stay on topic
- contribute constructively
- respect moderators

Toxic behavior may result in removal.

10. Content Removal Without Notice

Quantisca may remove content:

- without warning
- without explanation
- without obligation to restore it

Users have no right to appeal content removal.

11. Termination of Community Access

Quantisca may terminate access if:

- rules are violated
- harmful behavior occurs
- spam or abuse is detected
- legal risks arise
- the user poses a security threat

Termination does not entitle the user to refunds.

12. No Guarantee of Availability

Quantisca does not guarantee:

- community uptime
- preservation of content
- availability of features
- future access to discussions

The Community may be modified or discontinued at any time.

13. Governing Law

These Guidelines are governed exclusively by the laws of:
